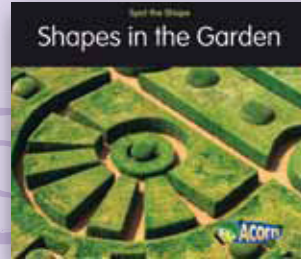

SHAPES IN GARDENS

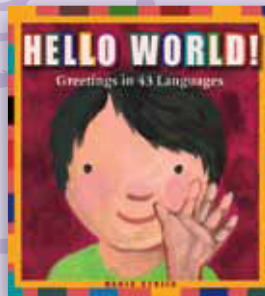

(Nursery, Key Stages 1 & 2)

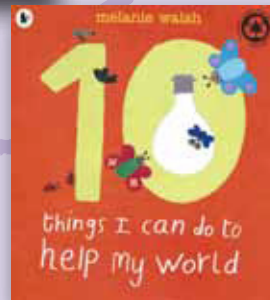
We all say hello in our own language, each and every day. With this book, children can learn 43 ways to say hello and appreciate cultures beyond their own.

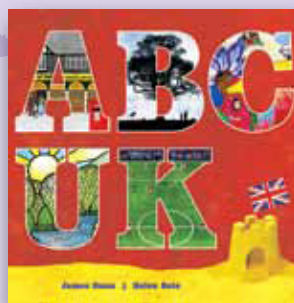

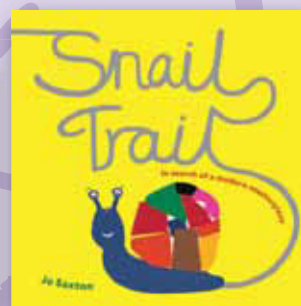
